If you choose to make a monetary donation, we will purchase the needed tools for you from Espey Hardware in Hildebran who has graciously offered the items at cost. After the purchase of tools, donations will be used for proper lettering, decals, insurance and to provide a fund for tool replacement and upkeep. 



- •Cash flow was positive for the month, but remains negative for the year.
 •We project a deficit of \$21,000 for 2024. (possibly less???)
- •We've pre-paid some items, so December's expenses should be a little lighter than usual.
- •I will move \$15,000 from our savings account into our checking account in late December or early January.

To return to Solid Green:

- Sufficient amount in checking account to keep operating balance from dipping into the negative at any point during that month.
- 35K "Reserves" in Savings Account


