



- As expected, cash flow was negative for the month and for the year.
 Our actual 2024 deficit was \$19,017.03, less than we projected (\$21,000).
- •I will move \$15,000 from our savings account into our checking account in January.

To return to Solid Green:

- Sufficient amount in checking account to keep operating balance from dipping into the negative at any point during that month.
- 35K "Reserves" in Savings Account


