WHY CHURCH PLANTING?

The idea of "church planting" runs all through the Book of Acts. The book traces how Christianity grew from a small group in Jerusalem into a movement that spread across the known world. The exact phrase "church planting" doesn't appear in the Greek, but the practice itself is everywhere in the story. The most well-known examples center on the Apostle Paul, yet Scripture actually shows several different ways new churches were started.

1. The "Mother Church" Model

The church in Antioch (in what's now Turkey) is the clearest biblical picture of a local church sending out leaders to start new churches.

The Send-off: In Acts 13:1–3, the leaders in Antioch were praying and fasting when the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

The Partnership: They didn't send Paul out alone. They sent a team. Antioch functioned as Paul's "home base," the church he returned to and reported back to after his journeys.

2. Paul's Three Missionary Journeys

Paul became the most prolific church planter in history, starting churches in key cultural and trade centers.

Galatia (First Journey): Paul and Barnabas planted churches in cities like Iconium, Lystra, and Derbe (Acts 14).

Philippi (Second Journey): This church began with a small prayer gathering by a river, where a businesswoman named Lydia believed. It later grew after a local jailer came to faith (Acts 16).

Corinth: Paul stayed here for about 18 months, working as a tentmaker while helping establish the church (Acts 18).

Ephesus (Third Journey): Paul remained in Ephesus for around three years. This church became a kind of hub, and many believe that the other "Seven Churches of Revelation" were planted by leaders trained by Paul in Ephesus (Acts 19).

3. The "Accidental" Plant

Scripture also shows that God often used hardship to start new churches.

Acts 8:1–4: After Stephen was executed, intense persecution broke out in Jerusalem. Believers were scattered throughout Judea and Samaria, and as they fled, they "preached the word wherever they went."

This means church planting wasn't always the result of a formal plan or committee. Sometimes it happened simply because believers moved to new places and shared the gospel there.

I believe healthy churches plant churches. So where are you planning your next church plant? One of the key roles of your association is to partner together in planting new churches. We really can do so much more together than we ever could on our own. As we celebrate our resurrected Lord this Easter season, let's pray how we can honor Him and carry out His command to go, baptize, teach and make disciples. (Matt. 28:18-20) Please reach out—I'd be honored to walk alongside your church in this planting journey.

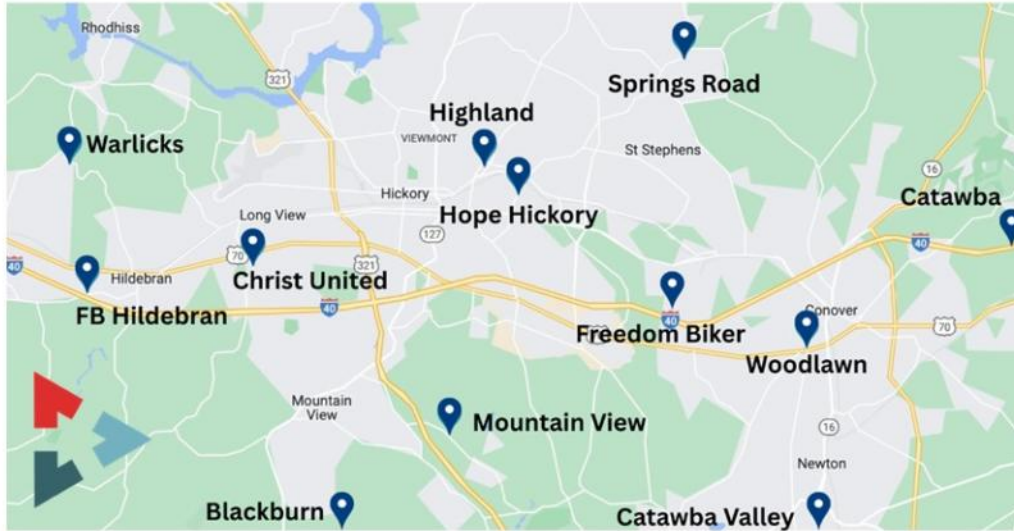

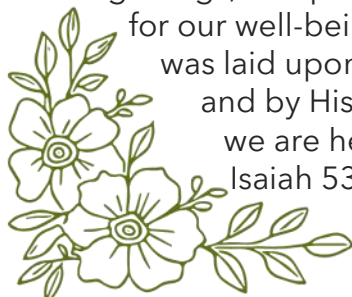

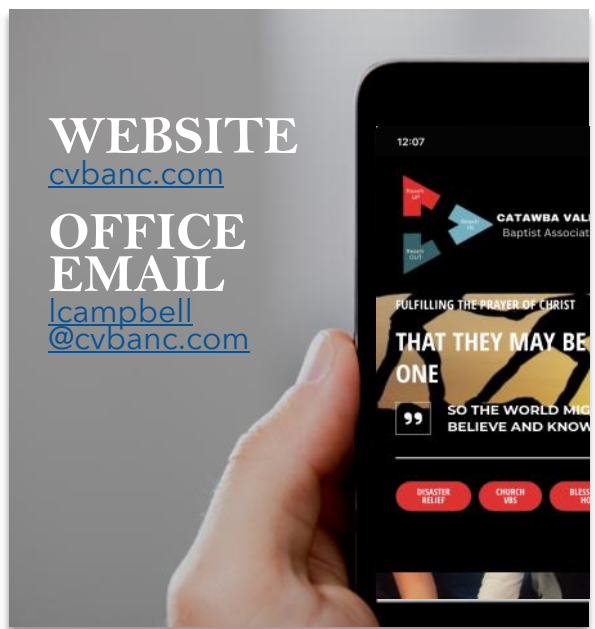
